As a new addition to the Summit, we are excited to host an afternoon breakout session, specifically designed for residents, faculty and residency program leaders to discuss and plan a scholarly project. The session will with an interactive design session to explore the potential for scholarly activity and innovation around the Reach Out and Read intervention. Residents will have time during the session to plan and prepare a proposal.
